What happened:

1. Constructing an herb snail.


2. Constructing an insect hotel.

Procedure and insights

Expectation: Everyday school life slightly different. Experiencing alternative teaching methods related to environmental protection during project days at a German secondary school.

Procedure: At two consecutive days the participants of the exchange took part in the construction of an herb snail and an insect hotel. Two groups mixed of school pupils and exchange participants worked together on the construction projects.

During the work in the school garden the background of the projects were investigated in deep discussions.



Intercultural exchange: Gaining experience in the teamwork with children of different origin.

Teambuilding: Joined organization and realization of a given project in a limited time frame.

Intercultural insights:

- Both constructs were unknown to the CNCC. Especially the insect hotel was looked at with curiosity.
- From the Tanzanian viewpoint the pupils exhibited a strong identification and motivation with the given projects.
- The guests appreciated the special action day at school and the good equipment.
