- **Place:** NABU Nature Conservation Center Federsee
- **Date:** 01/August – 02/August/2019
- **Participants:** Personal of the Nature Conservation Center Federsee and the NABU with CNCC.
- **What happened:**
 1. Introduction to the concept of the Nature Conservation Center.
 2. Guided tours to the Federsee boardwalk, the wobbly woods and the Federsee fen.
 3. Visit of the archeological Federsee Museum.

Procedure and insights

Expectations: Getting an introduction to the nature conservation work in the Federsee area, which is with 33 km² the largest fen area of Southwestern Germany.

Procedure: After the theoretical introduction to the concept of the nature conservation work in the Federsee area, excursions were performed.

In a guided tour on the boardwalk not only nature was explained but also the methodical input why the individual information is given to the visitors at specific points.

The excursion to the wobbly wood was dominated by practically experiencing how the forest ground and surrounding trees can be moved by rhythmic movement of a group. A phenomenon that is only possible to observe on fenland.

In the fenland it was possible to observe plants, which have survived since the ice age.

Educative methods:

Classic presentation: Lecture with explanations.

Classic guided tours: Excursion with explanation stops and didactical input.

Intercultural insights:

- The Tanzanian guests did not know these kinds of wetlands.
- Some artifacts of the museum are still commonly used in Tanzania.
